Re: AUMPathway agreement between BAS/BA in Information Systems and MA in Organizational Leadership

Date: September 21, 2021 (Revision)

Pursuant to Graduate Regulations related to Accelerated Undergraduate to Master's Pathway (AUMP) (G-8), the MA in Organizational Leadership and the BAS/BS in Information Systems programs establish the following agreement to allow students to accelerate their attainment of the MA degree in Organizational Leadership by beginning master's level coursework during their undergraduate career.

The BAS/BS program in Information Systems agrees to accept and apply up to 12 credits of course work in Organizational Leadership towards the upper division elective courses in the BAS/BS in Information Systems degree program.

The MA program in Organization Leadership agrees to allow students who meet the university's qualification for the AUMP to enroll in up to 15 credits of OL courses that will count towards completion of the MA in Organizational Leadership.
