### **Meeting AGENDA:**

#### 1. Short Scenario & Discussion

Student smoking by Maske hall dropped a cigarette in the grass starting a fire, the dry grass around Maske hall started burning & spreading the fire. A student passing by saw the fire and ran to an Emergency phone tower north of WUC. CPS responds, Fire Dept is requested, and Maaske hall is getting evacuated. When FD arrives, they see fire has spread over to Winters Hall. Rebecca activates WOU CERT Team for crowd control and building evacuation support at Winters hall.

What do you do, what do you grab to take with you, where do you go?

- Activation would come via auto text messages with something like: fire by Winters hall (MNB
  – math/nursing building), CERT team respond for assignments east side (front) of Winters hall
  to Director CPS Rebecca.
- Grab- CERT BAG with PPE, & first aid kit), & Phone.
  - Discussion about essential to have CERT Security vest/ID on Lanyard we are looking into cost and purchasing so each CERT member would have safety vest.
  - $\circ$  Wearing vest and ID help emergency responders recognize you are part of the requested response.
- If assisting with evacuation, sweeping building, clearing bathrooms, using firm voice to instruct individuals in the building to leave to designated area.
- Might be instructed to help keep crowd control, keep people out of the building, keep cars from parking and watching on Monmouth Ave.
