*All program completers must pass the required teacher performance assessment (TPA) which, in most cases, is the edTPA for the subject matter area aligned to the endorsement earned by the candidate. For the 2022-2023 year, some candidates (UG) completed a locally-designed assessment. For the 2023-2024 year SPED was the only area that used edTPA, all other programs used WOU's TPA to assess candidates. All completers, however, passed the required TPA as a condition of completion.
