Why Division of Education and Leadership

1. Education leadership or educational leadership = administration programs and PhD programs
2. Education and leadership
 - Education is broad enough to include working with educators in a variety of professions:
 - Museum educators, community college faculty, higher education professionals, trainers, curriculum planners, instructional designers, community educators, environmental educators, content developers
 - Captures the leadership endorsements, certificates and specializations already offered
 - Allows for future administration program
 - Allows for possible Interdisciplinary programs that are not solely focused on K-12 licensing
