### Study abroad program agenda and minutes review.

- Ya-Fang Cheng shares the agenda and meeting notes for the week, including a review of last semester's minutes and a continuation of ideas for the board.
- o Ya-Fang Cheng plans to create presentation slides for faculty senate and invite Provost and Bev to discuss study abroad program.

### • International recruitment fair and agent contracts.

- o Macade meets with 73 international recruitment agents in Miami, with majority from India.
- o Macade hopes to secure 30-40 agent contracts after a lengthy and labor-intensive process.

#### International student recruitment and partnerships.

- Macade highlights the diversity of international agents and potential for recruitment, while Cheng and Pelegrin Taboada inquire about contacting institutions abroad.
- Recruiters express interest in bringing more international students to Western, but lack resources.
- o Joseph discusses challenges with reporting structure and resource allocation.
- Ya-Fang Cheng inquires about finding previous partners for cooperation and documentation.

#### Study abroad program's future plans and survey.

Audrey discusses the status of Study Abroad program with students, despite being on pause.

# • Gathering information for study abroad program post-COVID.

- o Faculty discuss the purpose of collecting data on study abroad experiences, acknowledging program hiatus and tension.
- Committee seeks to gather information for rebuilding post-COVID program.
- o Faculty discussed who was responsible for the pause.

## Gathering voices for study abroad program via survey

- Ya-Fang Cheng and Sean Roush discuss timeline for presenting
  Faculty Senate report, agreeing on two weeks from date of sending for reasonable turnaround time.
- o Participants discuss adding open-ended questions to survey to gather more detailed information.

# • International education opportunities at a university.

- o Participants discuss the importance of international education and experiences for students, with some viewing it as a luxury and others as a systemic issue.
- o Participants discuss the feasibility of a study abroad program, with a focus on challenges and opportunities.

# • Study abroad program and faculty senate meeting.

- o Committee members discuss potential meeting with Tina and Bev West before faculty senate presentation.
- o Faculty discuss study abroad program goals, challenges, and potential solutions for a March meeting with Provost.
- Committee members discuss and brainstorm ideas for a survey to gauge interest on campus, with a focus on shared governance and prioritizing questions to ask.
