<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bilingual and Diverse Teaching Scholarship (BDTS) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Successfully complete a minimum of 36 credits by the end of the Spring term (academic year). • Maintain a minimum of 2.75 *cGPA. • Maintain enrollment in eligible major as required by the Bilingual and Diverse Teacher Scholars Program. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Awards are determined by the Bilingual and Diverse Teacher Scholars Program (department). • Must answer “Yes” to the question: “Are you interested in a career in teaching?” on the Admissions application during the Admissions application process. • Contact WOU’s Admissions Office to confirm your answer to the “career in teaching?” question if you are not sure or your original response.
