





Attendance Snapshot

- Pack Welcome Week—725 students to 2 signature events (Dance 375 and Game Night 350)
- 1st and 2nd day of photos Fall Term—393 students
- Homecoming—360 students for the carnival
- Holiday Tree Lighting—1000 people plus
- Groove in the Grove—500 students in Spring term 2023
- Lavender and Black Graduation in Spring Term 2023 had approximately 125 graduates between the two events.
- Prep week activities—approximately 170 students for Fall Term and Spring Term 2023--150 across all activities
- Make and Takes were super popular and we ran out. (paint by number kits, etc).
- Discover Leadership cohort is full at 18 students this term.
- Wolf Awards celebrated 50 students with 39 different awards

Even with a smaller incoming class count and decreased enrollment, we had increased participation numbers (1%)







Enhancements

We are incredibly thankful for the funding level from last year given the previous two IFC budget cycles resulted in LIA budget cuts of 29% or \$16,843 total for both years.

We are asking for 2 on going enhancements to be considered.

- \$5,370. For Spanish translation services. We would use Oregon Certified Interpreters, that WOU has a contract with, for help translating documents, posters, brochures, and other materials to Spanish in our effort to support WOU's emerging HSI status. Google translation is not reliable as it misses context cues.
- \$1,611 for cultural and/or identity-based celebrations and programming. \$500 each term. Collaborations with other departments and student organizations, materials or decorations for inside the WUC, etc. F23-1 event for 435ppl, W24-3events for 60ppl, S24-5events for 760ppl, F24-7events for 563ppl.
