### 5. Large Budget Presentations

- Student Engagement - Chelsee Blatner
  - i. Kira: In LIA 10% budget cut you mentioned Spanish translation cut. Could you tell us more about that?
    - 1. Chelsee: We will still have some funds to do Spanish translation just not as much. Do our best to the commitment of being an HSI, we will still have some translations. Just reduced position.
  - ii. Ema: Travel in the LIA budget is that for all students or do you have to be in a program?
    - 1. Chelsee: Travel in LIA budget is connected to events and programs that we are doing or sponsoring attendance too.

  - i. Brooke: Why does your cut package not include KWOU?
    - 1. Linden: Printing needed to be reduced and not the tech parts in case they fell apart. KWOU relies on tech and reducing that leaves us in a vulnerable position.
  - ii. Kira: Why do you use the printing place that you use now? Are there other options? Anywhere else cheaper?
    - 1. Linden: I looked at other places but they don't fulfill what we are looking for. Really good relationship with Eagle Web Press. We are also able to do other fun things with them.

1. Linden: Meet with students bi-weekly and not in capacity to meet with all students. Want more roles? Absolutely, an audio translator. Paid for with Foundation funds.

  1. Linden: I think I handle it all very well. Don't know if another coordinator is in the budget. Attributed to the student media handbook.
- v. Kira: Goal to get back to print every week without cutting student positions?
  1. Loren: Not a goal. We do like what we have now. The main goal is accessibility. What can we do outside our typical content production to give back to the University and students. That is a big goal. That is why we are partnering with the VRC, doing free student portraits, Boxes of Hope, and leadership conference.

  1. Linden: Yes, we do virtual programming for online only students.
- vii. Ema: You said you would reduce printing if there was a cut package, how many times you print or how many copies?
  1. Linden: We don't know yet. In July they give us pricing. Then we look and figure out what the best option is. More issues or times printing.
- viii. Ema: How many students do you have recurring working for you?
  1. Linden: Typically 95% of the time someone is returning. Multiple that have been there three plus years.
- ix. Rhylie: Audio translations spanish/english?
  1. Linden: Both. We need a human to do it.
