5. Old Business
- Final Decision
 - i. Budget Allocation
 1. Rhylie: We tabled it to this meeting, so you had more time to think about budget allocations.
 2. Ema: I feel Evan's comment that we did not ask for increases that we should just go ahead with what we have in place. Maybe recommend to ask for increases in future even if we do not give them.
 3. Brooke: Feel the same way. We should just go with preliminary decision.
 4. Kira: You mean enhancement when you say increases?
 - a. Brooke: Yes.
 5. Madi: Last week I brought up a 2.5% cut to athletics to cover the cost for a new Wolf Ride van. I think it is something to look at.
 - a. Cody Lynn: What is the dollar amount?
 - i. \$23,611.80
 6. April: Last week it would be nice if we could hear from Athletics what the impact would be of a 2.5 cut.
 - a. Randi: We would look at our cut package and look at equipment and student employment. Look at all the events and maybe not fund Wolfie for all events and charge departments. Equipment we could do fundraising for. \$23,000 does not seem a lot but it is. Our scholarships come from Lottery funding or fundraising.
 7. Brooke: Money pulled from scholarships but that is not in your cut package?
 - a. Randi: If \$23,000 was cut from equipment or student employment and we can't find places to cut that we would pull from self-funded and that is scholarship and other areas.
 8. Cody Lynn: Wolf Ride, is not in greatest condition, it would need to be fixed?
 - a. Brittany: I feel super bad that you did not entertain enhancements and not thinking about cutting someone. I do not know how long the van will last. It needs more work, after work, after work.
 - b. Cody Lynn: If it needs so much work, we need to take that into consideration. It is a resource that students utilize.
 9. Ema: Is there other places you pull money from?
 - a. Brittany: Only funded by IFC.
 10. Tina: I guided Brittany to help this group understand how to fund Wolf Ride. We may request to borrow from reserve to replace WOLF Ride. We are spending money on maintenance. Repairs have been manageable. In next couple of years this van needs to be replaced. Is it urgent, probably

not, in next year or two, probably so. Camarie, could WOLF Ride borrow from IFC reserve to replace van?

- a. Camarie: I believe that if there is an emergency it could be requested from the IFC reserves, but I will look it up.
11. Tina: This could be a topic to be brought to the IFSC.
12. Kira: Great that it was brought up, to make us think about it.
13. Madi: What does fundraising look like?
 - a. Brittany: We could fundraise.
14. Ema: Who would do the fundraising.
 - a. Brittany: We have 5 Wolf Ride students we could ask to help.

29. Cody Lynn: I would like to discuss Athletics and Wolf Ride more. I am afraid that if Wolf Ride shuts down it takes a resource from students that do not have cars on campus. I really think we should take that inconsideration.
30. Rhyllie: There are other ways to fund Wolf Ride.
31. Brooke: If we are funding Wolf Ride by cutting Athletics would not be as beneficial as using the reserves.
32. Madi: If they do wait they will keep pushing money into the reserves. That takes money away from student employment and operating hours.
33. Kira: Athletics seems to have lots of fundraising areas. Wolf Ride does not have fundraising. Randi, do you have a number for fundraising?
- Randi: This year \$333,000 in camp revenue before expenses. \$45,000 after expenses. \$68,000 from ticket sales, \$637,000 from auction, \$150,000 after expenses. Not enough to cover all our expenses. This is not extra, this is part of our operation. We partner with different areas on campus, softball game next week 50% of ticket sales go to Abby's House. I was not at Open Hearing but students were there to talk about their experiences, is it appropriate for more students to come from the bigger areas to talk?
 - Ema: I feel, nicer to hear from bigger variety from athletics. Not just football.
 - Brooke: There were a lot of athletes. Rugby, track, softball, football.
 - Madi: Rugby is Campus Rec, not Athletics.
34. April: Would it be possible to fundraise with Wolf Ride?
- Brittany: I would think that we would work the Foundation office and then maybe there is an opportunity for a collaboration.
35. Evan: Camarie, if there is an emergency situation with a capital expense, if there a way for it to come out of the reserve?
- Rhyllie: Already talked about and the answer is yes.

- b. Evan: Not to push my opinion, but think about who were at the Open Hearing, and how you would explain a cut to fellow students. I hear you want to solve a problem but there alternatives to that.
 - 36. Ema: Do we know how many students mentioned Wolf Ride in Open Hearing?
 - a. Rhylie: I will look it up. There was feedback for Wolf Ride that was not positive.
 - b. Kira: Just the one that said Wolf Ride was stupid.

 - d. Rhylie: Comment that the trolley goes at the same time. None that say give Wolf Ride more money.
