

Obtaining an Oregon State Driver's License

It is important to note that you will get a limited term license as you are only temporarily in the United States. A limited term license expires on the same date as your authorized length of stay.

What do I need to get an Oregon driver's license?

- Study the [Oregon Driver Manual](#);
- Fill out the [application](#);
- Take it to a [DMV office](#);
- Show proof of your [residence address and legal presence/identity](#)
 - Unexpired foreign passport with a current admittance stamp and I-94 with the actual date in the “Admit Until” field.
 - A bill or other “official” document showing your current address of residence. If you do not have any documents that would verify your physical address, please request a letter of Address Verification from the Office of International Education and Development.
- Pass a [vision test](#);
- Optional - take the [practice knowledge test](#);
- Pass the [knowledge test](#);
 - There is a \$5 fee each time that you take the test. The test is available in English, Spanish, Arabic, Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Russian and Vietnamese.
 - Online testing available.
- Optional - [Get Driver Training](#) or get an [instruction permit](#);
- Call to [schedule a drive test](#);
- Pass the [drive test](#) with [DMV](#);
 - There is a \$9 fee each time that you take the driver's test. Only you and the examiner are allowed in the vehicle.
 - You must provide a passenger vehicle with a valid registration that is in proper working order.
 - You must show proof of insurance.
- Pass the [drive test](#) with a [class C testing business](#);
 - Provide drive tests approved by DMV.
 - Set their own fees and days of operation.
 - Test only for Class C non-commercial license applicants.
- Pay the [fees that apply](#); and
- Get your picture taken.
 - **Photo Rules** - These items are **not** allowed in a photo:
 - Eyeglasses;
 - Sunglasses;
 - Hat or head covering (other than religious);
 - Contacts that change the appearance of the eye;
 - Face paint;
 - Stickers or bandages; or
 - Anything that covers your face or changes your appearance.
