Note: Consult a History Department advisor in developing your plan. This may include History 407 seminars on topical/regional areas offered on a periodic basis. With prior approval from Hist. Advisor, students may plan a Program that includes up to 9 hours of Social Science electives relevant to their concentration across history to complete the 44 hour sequence.			
Students will use a paper completed for an upper-division history course at WOU as a foundation for their Senior Seminar thesis. They will revise and expand this topical paper, with history department advisers, across the senior year to complete Senior Seminar (HST 499) in the spring term. HST 420 should be taken the term preceding HST 499.			
In HST 420 the student will explore the theoretical foundations of the research topic theoretical foundations of the research topic that will become the basis for the HST 499 senior thesis paper.
