  - Giving Day will happen on Tuesday, March 4. If your direct office would like to be on that page to raise funds, please get in touch with Dave as soon as possible and he can create a page for your office.
  - Staff for Student Scholarship this is a fund sponsored by Staff Senate. Right now, we have about \$200 in the account which is around \$800 short of what we need to offer a scholarship next year. WOU has a payroll deduction option that would allow you to make a monthly contribution directly from your payroll to this scholarship fund. It is tax-deductible and can be allocated directly to the Staff for Students funds or multiple funds. If we had 20 WOU employees give \$5 per month, that's it our goal would be met, and this scholarship would be funded. If at some point, we have 40-50 WOU employees committed to \$5-\$20 per month then we start exceeding our goal and can begin having conversations about awarding multiple students a scholarship, or setting up an endowment, etc. However, as it stands, we continue to scramble each year to come up with enough funds to get just one scholarship each year.
    - Giving Day is really a crowdfunding opportunity, so if you are thinking about donating and looking for that one time option, please do it on March 4 to be a part of that giving day campaign.
