Vice President's Corner

- Other shared governance information, elections, reminders, etc.
- Update from Faculty Senate Meeting:
 - President's Note: Return to Campus and offering in-person courses was the main topic for his presentation.
- Our 2023-24 first-time, full-time student retention rate was 76% and our 6-year graduation rate was 45%.
 - For some perspective, those numbers were:
 68% and 44%, at Southern Oregon University,
 67% and 37% at Eastern Oregon University,
 and averaged 73% and 52% at our other official peer institutions.
- Recruitment for Staff Senate
 - An email went out today asking staff to vote in candidates for the open seats. So far, we have had two candidates for unclassified positions and one candidate for the classified seat.
