 2. Antonia questioned the CAA position reduction to 10 months. Is there a plan to distribute extra work to other staff members? Would the cutting of a PA affect this? – Chelsee stated that July and August would be off for them which is a quieter time.
 3. Shelby asked if the Media coordinator was considered for the cut to 10 months. Chelsee stated that they are more active during summer with virtual programs.

VI. Further discussion about Space Utilization within the WUC when Dean of Students and Student Conduct move out.

- A. Any additional thoughts about proposal from ASWOU-
 1. One meeting in Mosaic Center – just figuring it all out, student reps getting counsel together but no talk about moving.
 2. Shelby – Who is in charge and how did it become a space without going through WUC board? Chelsea – Still not a definitive oversight committee. Space was offered since it was available, as a stepping stone to be used until all things were decided.
 3. Suggestion to wait until the committee can meet together
 4. Kristen questioned if the Mosaic center was notified that ASWOU wants to move into that space and Morgan confirmed that they had. Morgan notes that some members of the Mosaic center do want a different space that has doors that close and lock, and a more private space. BSU thought it would be a good idea.
 5. Shelby- does ASWOU want to take on the space and figure out the Mosaic space later? Things are feeling rushed. Morgan – does not want ASWOU split up, that would be too difficult. Needs to have directors near her office.
 6. Kristen – have any other departments requested to move in the Dean of Students office? Chelsea told a couple already no. Process would be the same if someone in the building wanted to move.
 7. Shelby – What are we waiting for exactly? What say does this board really have in the end?
 8. Chelsea – sounds like everyone wants more information from Mosaic center counsel and decisions should be made at the next meeting. Morgan suggested the same and was confident that they will want to move. Shelby agrees that all should be prepared with proposals at the March meeting. The meetings are becoming redundant.

9. Antonia – who is point of contact to coordinate the meetings for Mosaic? Tina-but it is unclear who is really in charge of the space. Is there going to be a student president? Will they have representation on this board? Yes per Chelsea. Shelby – wants to see it be well supported so it doesn't fall through the cracks again. Needs a good structural support.
10. Kristen – Can we submit questions so we make sure all bases are covered for next meeting? Chelsea- yes send to her or Ben. Shelby wants to see more from the students to see what they want.
11. Morgan – Would a statement from Mosaic be helpful? Shelby just wants to hear what the students want. Kristen we should just be the final formality – students decide what they want before we can vote.
