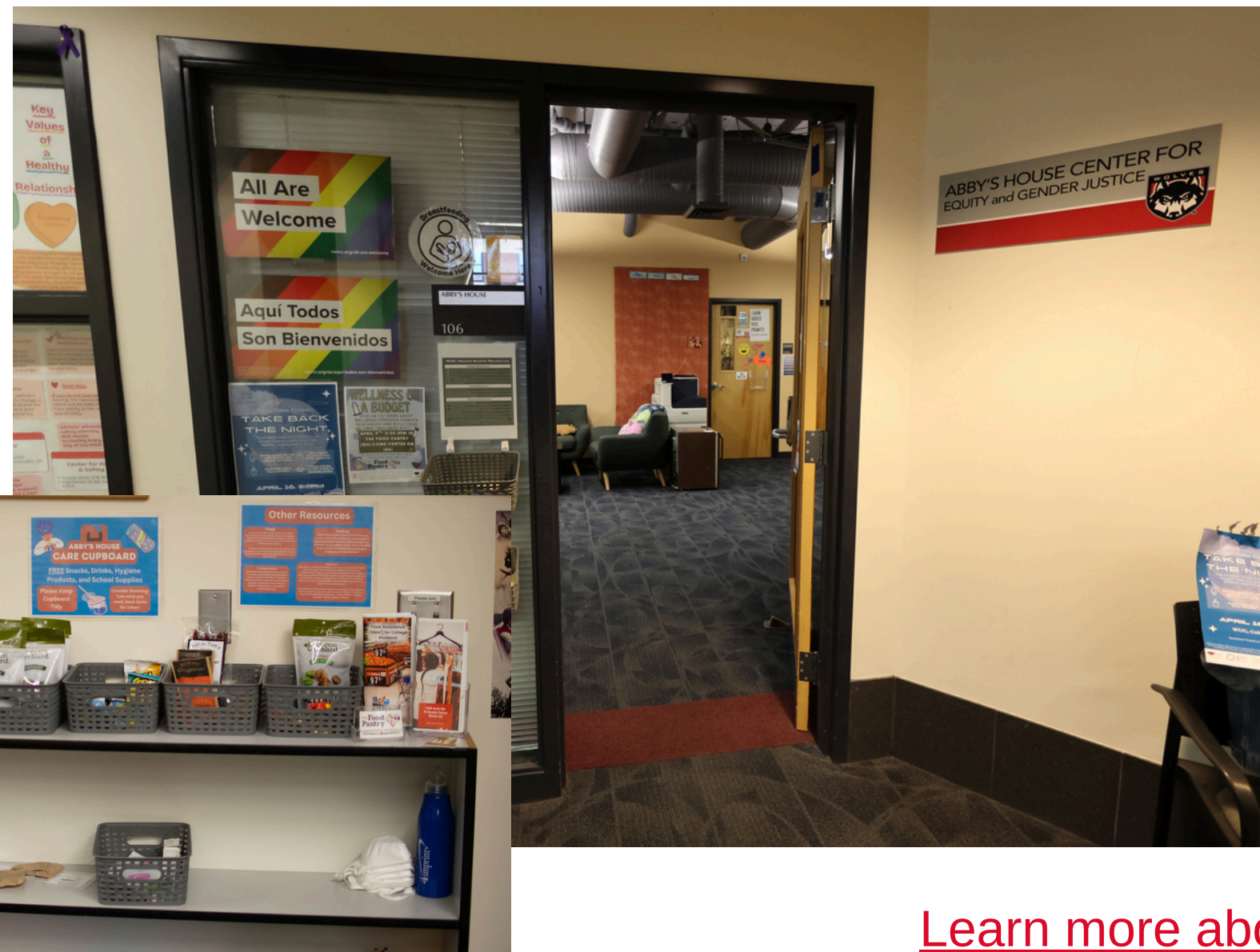

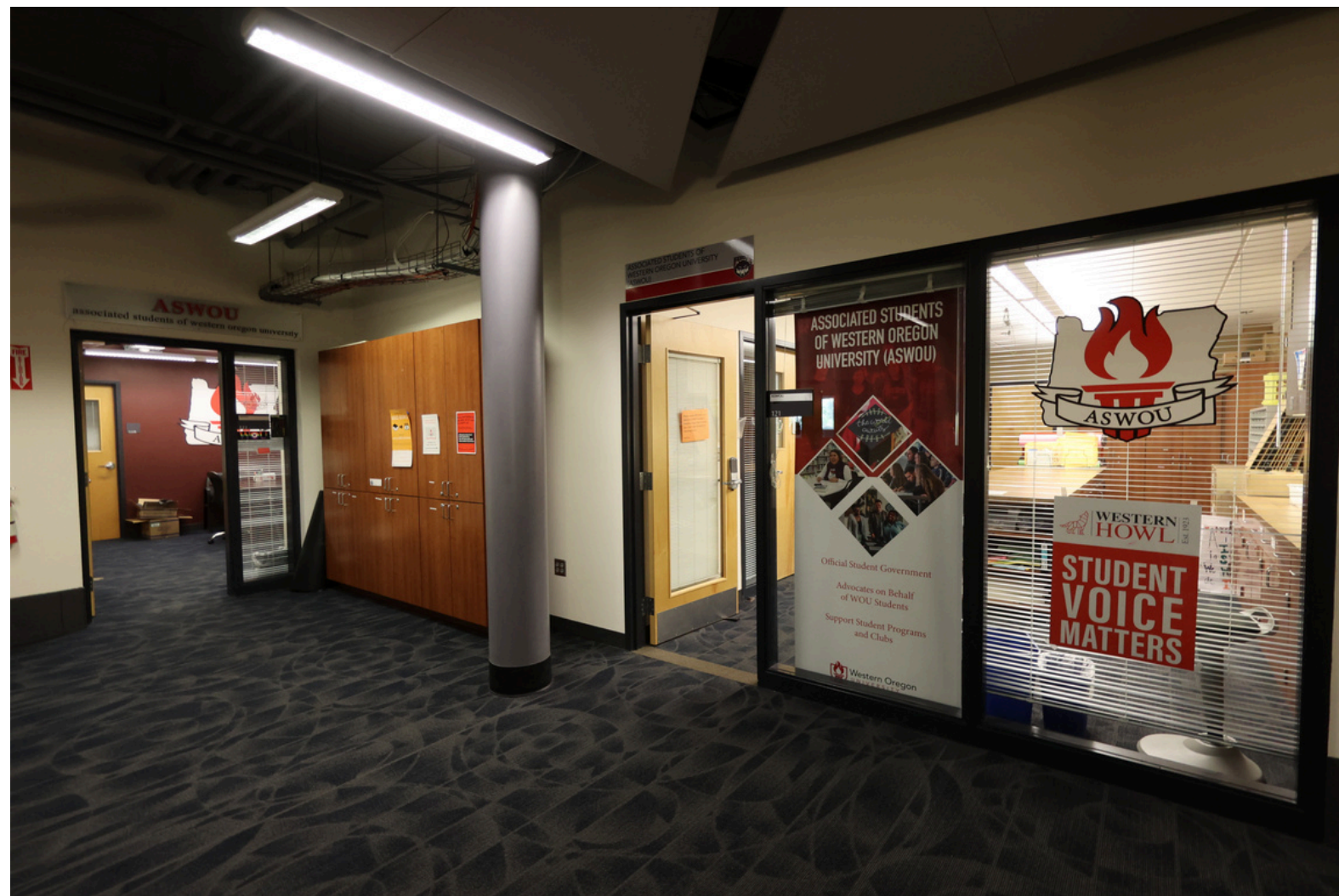


New Student & Family Programs provides orientation programs for new undergraduate students and their families. They also run family programs for all students throughout the year.
