She established a Pediatric Forensic Exam Clinic in Meridian, MS. She has taught the SANE Course for nurses across the US through Marshall University, West Virginia University, The Office for Victims of Crime, The Department of Justice, and Indian Health Services. Mrs. Sharp is currently a member of the IAFN (International Association of Forensic Nurses) Government Affairs Committee.
